
Healthcare market: Macro overview

...with high level of urbanization...






Important healthcare regulations in Vietnam that enabled the rise in private hospitals

Loosening of the regulations for private hospitals opens opportunities for private hospitals to grow



Health Insurance Law 2014

Public health insurance can be used in all hospitals, including private hospitals graded at the same level as public hospitals (district, provincial, national). In other words, patients could admit to private hospitals, with equal benefit and claim amounts from the health insurance program. Especially, if patients are admitted to any districtlevel hospitals, patients could have 100% of hospital fees fully covered by the national insurance fund.



Decree 16/2015/ND-CP

2015

The government will slowly phase out financial support for public hospitals, and let the hospitals gain full control of their budget planning.







Circular 39/2018/TT-BY


The circular regulates the minimum requirements to open hospital and provide services, such as: minimum gross floor area/bed, minimum healthcare workers/bed, minimum number of beds in hospitals, etc. This also tightens the standard in treating patients for all hospitals, including the maximum number of surgeries done per day, maximum number of beds operated/total registered number of beds. This is regulated under standards TCVN 9212:2012, TCVN 9213:2012, TCVN 4470:2012.

Healthcare market overview

Hospitals are integral part of the healthcare system







The current system still requires lots of work to meet the growing demand for quality healthcare services. In the last five years, there is a rising number of private hospitals that were opened to fulfill the demand. However, the healthcare system still lacks the capacity in hospital beds to meet the surge in patients.

Tan Phu General Hospital project was developed on an 5.185-sqm area at Le Trong Tan Street, adjacent to Tan Binh Industrial Park. 
